DENTAL HYGIENIST

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: The work involves application of technical knowledge in the field of dentistry. An incumbent may assist in the planning and performs activities necessary to the conduct of a preventive and treatment program. The work is carried out under general supervision. Supervision of the work of others is not normally a responsibility of this class. A <u>Dental Hygienist</u> does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- Provides dental prophylaxis and other hygiene measures, including instruction in home care of the mouth;
- Applies medicaments, such as fluorides to aid in arresting dental decay;
- Performs oral examination, evaluates oral conditions, and refers patients for corrective dental care;
- Counsels patients regarding necessity of regular preventive care and sources of care within the community;
- Advises of the importance of diet and nutrition to good dental health;
- May specialize in providing clinical services and health education in programs designed to improve and maintain oral health of children;
- May lecture community organizations and other interested groups on oral hygiene using motion pictures, charts, and other visual aids to augment service of dentist;
- Maintains records and makes reports used in evaluation of the work;
- Charts conditions of decay and disease for diagnosis and treatment by a dentist.

<u>FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES</u>, <u>SKILLS</u>, <u>ABILITIES</u>, <u>AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS</u>: Working knowledge of the principles and practices of dental hygiene; working knowledge of the basic principles, practices, and techniques of dental health education; skill in communicating the principles of effective dental care to others; ability to prepare effective dental health education materials; good hand and eye coordination; good judgement; initiative; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

<u>MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS</u>: Possession of a license to practice dental hygiene issued by the New York State Department of Education.
