of the position. Direct supervision is exercised of lifeguards. Life Guards Supervisors do

related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Supervises life guards and other staff assigned to pool area;

Ensures that pool rules are enforced;

Assigned life guards to their posts;

Give swimming instructions to beginners, advanced beginners, intermediates and advanced

swimmers;

Performs the duties of a life guard.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL

<u>CHARACTERISTICS</u>: Thorough knowledge of first aid and water rescue techniques; ability to

deal with the public in a firm yet friendly manner; ability to remain composed during emergency

situations; ability to supervise the work of others; ability to teach swimming; alertness and good

powers of observation; physical condition equal to the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: One season of experience as a life guard or swimming

instructor.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Possession of a Red Cross or Y.M.C.A. Senior Life Saving

Certificate.
