SEWAGE TREATMENT MAINTAINER

<u>GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES</u>: Assists in the operation of a sewage treatment plant; does related work as required.

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: The work is performed under the immediate supervision of a qualified operator, and shall consist of electrical and mechanical maintenance and miscellaneous outside maintenance work.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative only)

- Learns and assist in the making of tests to determine chlorine residual;
- Learns and assist in lab techniques;
- Cleans channels, screens, tanks, and other equipment;
- Assists in the preparation and maintenance of activity records and reports;
- Assists in the operation and adjustment of pumps, valves, screens, and related mechanical equipment;
- Observes demonstrations and otherwise learns the techniques of operation and maintenance of a sewage treatment plant;
- Assists in general line maintenance, with duties of cleaning and repairing leaks and new installation of taps and sewage lines.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES: Familiarity with elementary principles of chemistry and general science; good general intelligence; good observation; mechanical aptitude; ability to learn principles and procedures relating to operation and maintenance of a sewage treatment plant; ability to develop skill in the maintenance of pumps, valves, and related mechanical equipment; ability to get along well with others; ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions; industry and dependability; tact and courtesy; good physical condition.

<u>ACCEPTABLE EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING</u>: Graduation from a standard high school, and one year background in a related field such as plumbing, carpentry, construction, or electrical; or any equivalent combination of experience and training sufficient to indicate ability to do the work.
